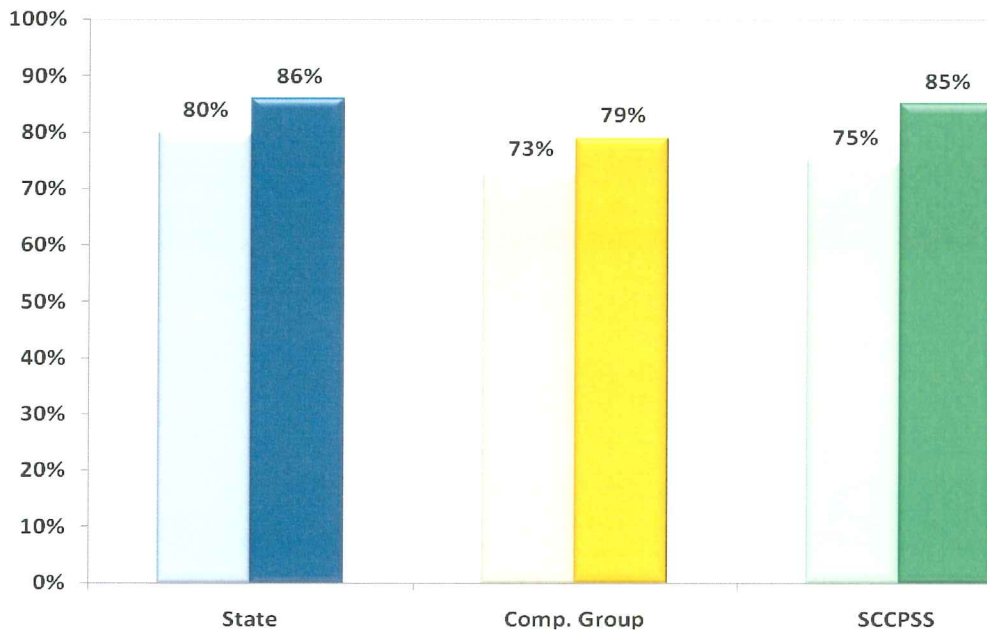

On October 1 the Georgia Department of Education released the final 2009 AYP results, which incorporate summer graduates and CRCT and GHS GT retest results.

The addition of the retest results allowed an additional two SCCPSS middle schools and four elementary schools to make AYP, and brought the percentage of elementary schools making AYP to 100%. Overall, a total of 85% of SCCPSS schools made AYP in the final release of results.

Figure 1 provides the final percentage of schools making AYP in 2008 and 2009 for the system, state, and comparison group. SCCPSS increased by 10 percentage points over last year, and surpassed the comparison group in both years.

Table 1 provides the final percentage of SCCPSS students meeting the AYP criteria for academic achievement and the second indicator from 2008 to 2009. Performance rose in all areas, with the greatest improvements occurring in graduation rate, particularly within the Economically Disadvantaged (ED) subgroup.

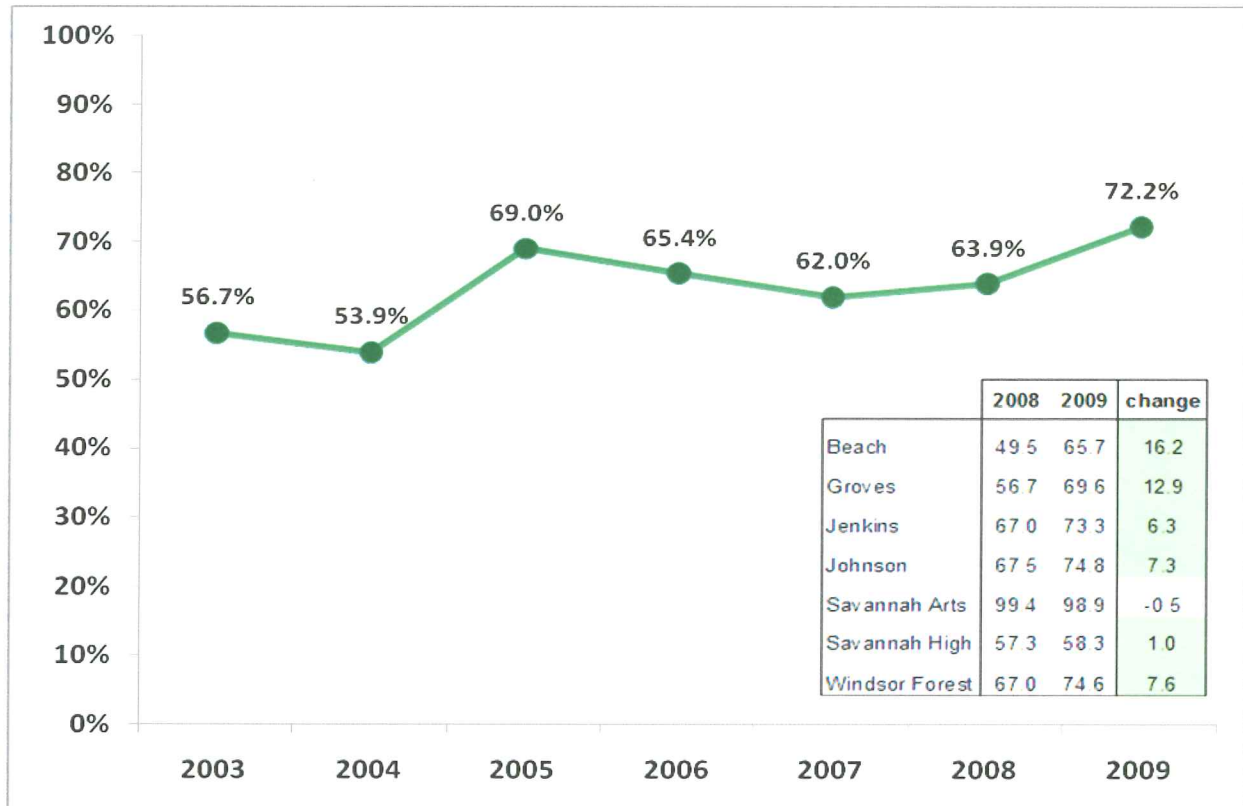

Figure 2 provides a historical analysis of SCCPSS graduation rates since 2003, along with a two-year comparison of graduation rates at the school level. SCCPSS increased the graduation rate by more than 8 points over last year and achieved a new all-time record. Graduation rates rose at 6 of the 7 high schools, with Beach earning the greatest increase, of more than 16 points.
